Properties

Lithofin KF Grout Cleaner dissolved organic dirt, especially oil and grease. After rinsing, the tiles and grout lines are hygenically clean.

Field of Use

For restoring the original colour and appearance of groutlines, and for thoroughly degreasing and cleaning grout in kitchens and bathrooms. Also suitable for cleaning baking trays, stoves, etc.

Directions for Use

Put a squirt of Lithofin KF Grout Cleaner onto a moist sponge and apply to the surface to be cleaned. Allow to work for 10 to 15 minutes. In case of very stubborn dirt, use neat and allow to work longer. Support the cleaner by brushing occasionally. Always rinse well with plenty of clear water.

<u>Please Note:</u> we highly recommend testing the product's suitability in an inconspicuous area prior to use. Do not use on surfaces sensitive to alkalines, such as polished marble, lacquered and varnished surfaces, etc. Do not use on hot surfaces. Coverage: approx. 10m² per litre.

Storage

Closed and cool. Do not store in temperatures above 25 °C. Shelf life approx. 3 years.

Surfactants are biologically degradeable in accordance with EU-regulations.
