	Floor Wear PEI Rating - Guidance for use as below
①	Floors with very little traffic. No abrasion. (eg Bathrooms)
2	Floors with light traffic. Light abrasion. (eg All rooms in the house except kitchens and rooms leading directly to the outside)
3	Floors with moderate traffic. Medium abrasion. (eg All rooms in the house, entrance ways must be protected with mats)
4	Floors with heavy traffic. High abrasion. (eg All rooms in the house, restaurants and light commercial)
(5)	Floors with very heavy traffic. High abrasion. (eg Commercial areas, Shopping Malls)
6	Unglazed tiles. Suitable for all very heavy traffic areas.
